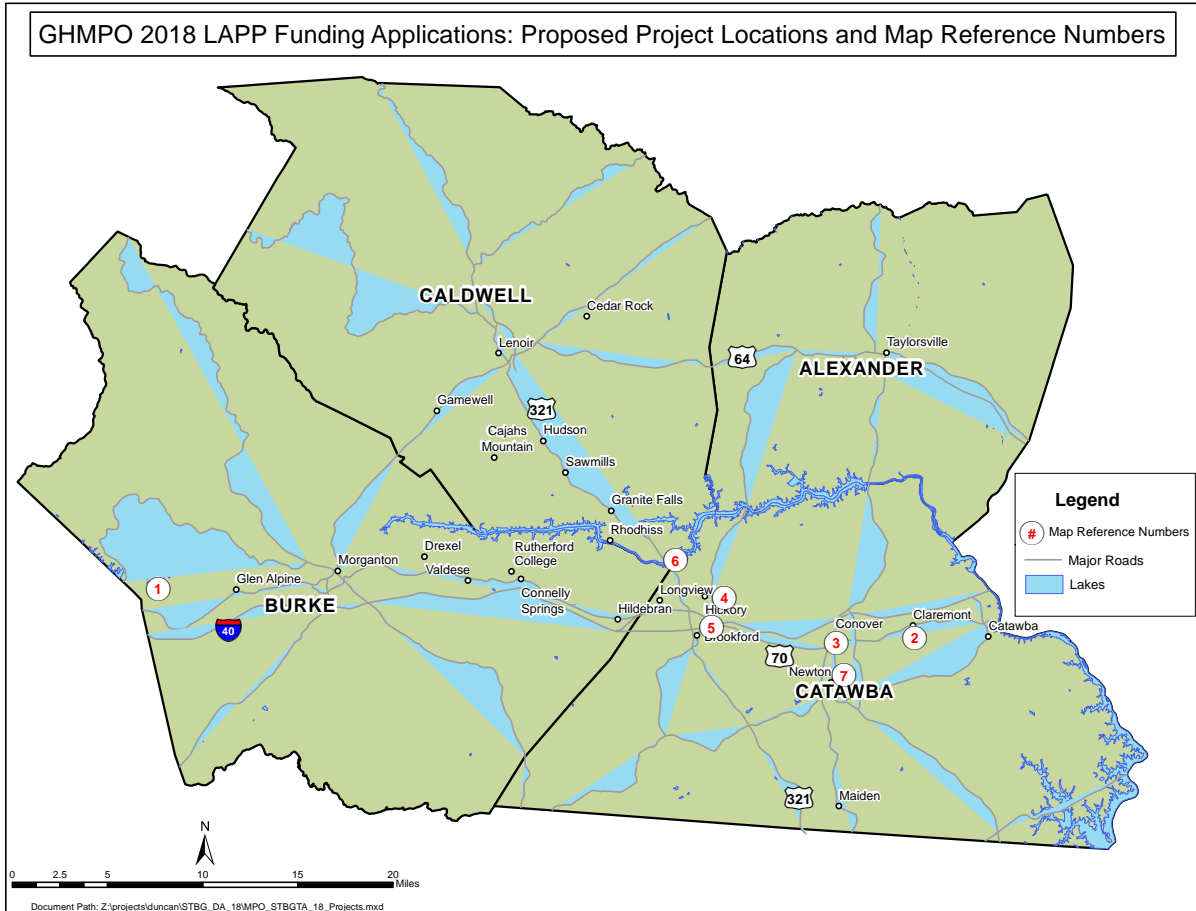


## Local Administered Project Program (LAPP) Submitted Applications

Seven LAPP applications were submitted to the GHMPO in 2018. Proposed projects are located in Burke and Catawba counties.



**1. Burke County – Fonta Flora State Trail (Linville Dam)**

Design boardwalk across the Linville Dam. The project is located on Duke Energy land and will continue the side path from EB - 5827, linking together the Southeastern and Southwestern sections of the FFST.

**2. City of Claremont – Centennial Blvd (Phase II) & Main St Sidewalks**

Extend sidewalk 2,592 linear feet along Centennial Boulevard (Phase II) and 864 linear feet along Main Street from where current sidewalk ends.

**3. City of Conover – Five Points Intersection**

Relocate existing overhead utilities and poles away from the intersection, replace existing signals and mounting poles with new signals mounted on mast arms, and install pedestrian crossing signals for all crosswalks.

**4. City of Hickory – Book Walk**

Construction of 3,180' long, 10' wide multi-use path from existing City Walk to Ridgeview Library.

**5. City of Hickory – Book Walk South**

Construction of 3,160' long, 10' wide multi-use path from Ridgeview Library to US 70/Walmart Community Grocery Store. If awarded, Book Walk South funds will be programmed for 2020.

**6. City of Hickory – River Walk**

Construction of a 3,360' long, 14' wide multi-use path from Old Lenoir Road and 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue NW to end of proposed Rosales Bridge.

**7. City of Newton – County Government Center Connection (Supplemental)**

Bike lane improvements, sidewalk construction and ADA improvements along A Street in downtown.

**8. Greenway Public Transportation – Preventative Maintenance**

Western Piedmont Regional Transit Authority, operating as Greenway Transit, requests funding for vehicle preventative maintenance. GHMPO's current allotment of funds allows for 10% of STBG-DA funds to be directed towards public transportation needs.
