

The town manager serves as the chief executive officer and manages operations in five departments with 25 full-time and nine part-time employees, while developing and administering an annual budget of \$5,239,250. The successful candidate must be a leader with strong interpersonal skills and a proven record of successful communication with elected officials, staff, and citizens. About The Taylorsville Community And Government

Located in Alexander County, the Town of Taylorsville is home to about 2,361 residents. Our wonderful community has an inviting, small town feel with a historic downtown and surrounding natural amenities that include both water and mountain recreation. Taylorsville is also ideally situated in the Western Piedmont Region, near fast-growing Hickory and about an hour drive to Charlotte, Asheville, and Boone.

The Town operates under the council-manager form of government and is comprised of a Mayor and four-member town council, elected at-large and serving four-year staggered terms. The Town has five departments: Administration (including Finance, HR, and Planning & Zoning); Police; Streets & Sanitation, Cemetery, and Water & Sewer. The town staff includes a total of 25 full-time and nine part-time employees.

The \$5,239,250 budget is divided into a \$2,606,400 General Fund and a \$2,632,850 Enterprise Fund (water/wastewater). The new manager will have immediate, exciting opportunities, including the new park/recreation renovations; a state appropriation of \$1.5 million for the installation of new sidewalks and street resurfacing; and on-going water & wastewater system assessment and associated capital projects. Specifically, the town has received \$1,455,130 for a wastewater capital project that includes lift station capacity upgrades, new force main installation, and equipment upgrades.
