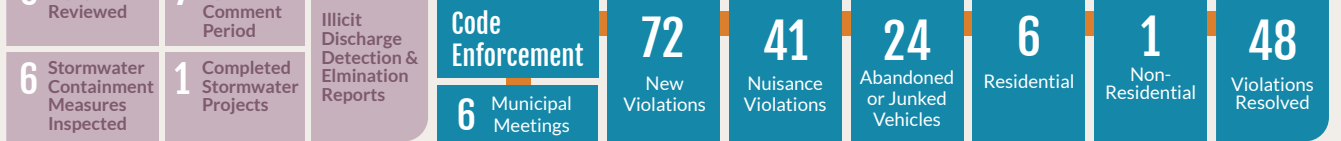
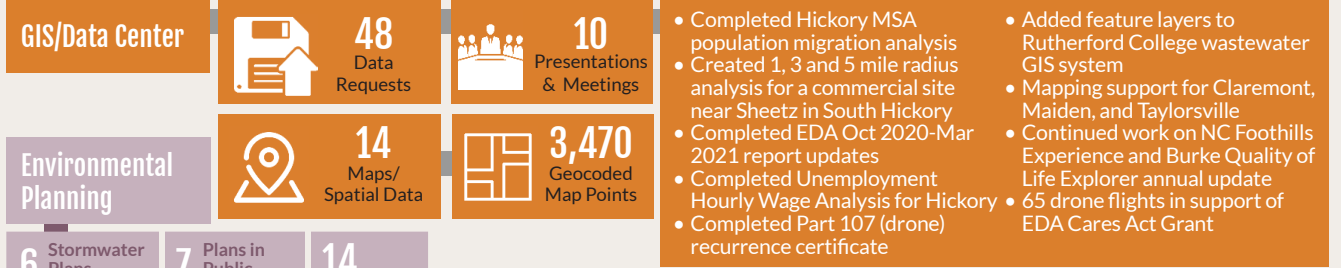
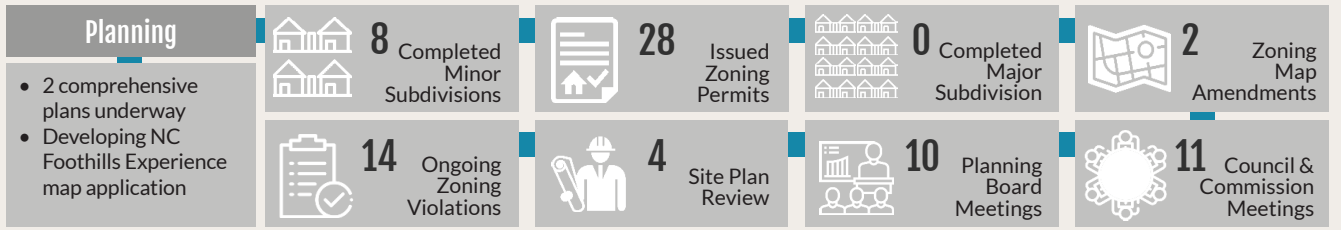

## Grants and Activities

- Signed 4 URP contracts in Burke County and signed 3 URP contracts in Caldwell. Bid opening for two ESFR in Burke.
- 5 under construction in Valdese SSH and 1 under construction in Caldwell ESFR and 3 under construction in Burke ESFR.
- Drexel received \$500,000 from the Golden LEAF Foundation to aid in the redevelopment of the Drexel Plant #1 brownfields site.
- Lenoir received notification from the Department of Housing and Urban Development the Unifour HOME Consortium has been awarded \$4,182,773 in HOME American Rescue Plan (ARP) funding. Projects funded with ARP should be designed to meet the needs of people experiencing or at risk of experiencing homelessness, including through development of affordable housing, tenant-based rental assistance, supportive services, and acquisition and development of non-congregate shelter units. All funds must be spent by 2030.

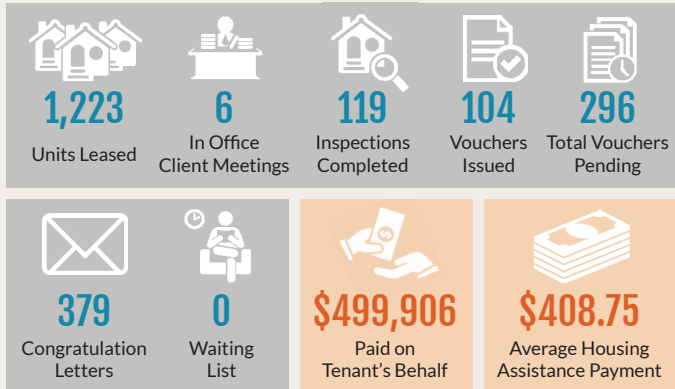

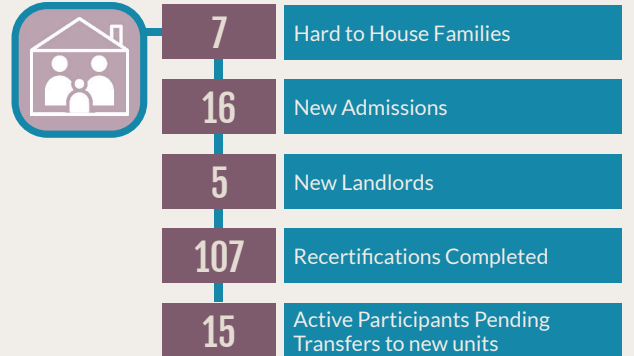

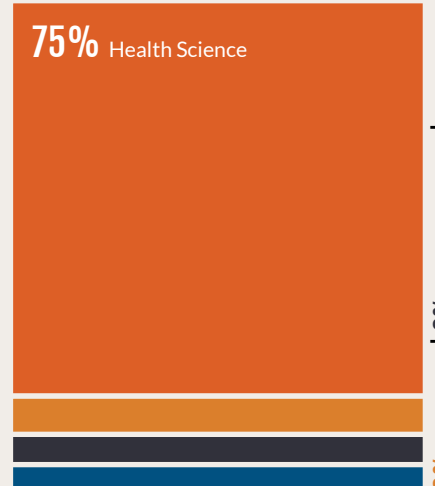
